The Summer Fun program is a summer day camp for all children **presently** in grades 1 through 5. The camp is run outdoors and includes an array of activities including sports, games, arts and crafts and much more! Currently there are two locations for Summer Fun. All children presently in grades 1 & 2 will attend Summer Fun at the Atkinson School from 8:30am until 12:30pm. All children in grades 3, 4 & 5 will attend Summer Fun at the Drummond Playground from 9:00am until 1:00pm. We can't wait to see you this summer!!!

This year Summer Fun will be held from Monday, June 28th to Thursday, August 5th for the Atkinson program, and from Monday, June 28th to Friday, August 6th for the Drummond Program. The fee for Summer Fun is \$280.00.

Dear Summer Fun Parents,

Welcome to NAYRS Summer Fun 2010! This year's Summer Fun Program will start on Monday June 28th for both camps and end Thursday August 5th for the Atkinson Program, and end Friday August 6th for the Drummond Program. Atkinson (present grades 1 & 2) begins at 8:30am and ends at 12:30pm. Drummond (present grades 3-5) will begin at 9:00am and end at 1:00pm. Calendars for the theme of the day and other activities will be given out during the first week of camp. These dates are always subject to change throughout the summer.

If it is raining out, there will be **NO** camp. If the weather is questionable before camp begins, you can call the North Andover Youth and Recreation Services at (978) 682-9000. If it starts raining during camp and appears like it is not going to stop, the children will be taken inside and we ask that you come pick them up.

Children are asked to bring some snacks and plenty of liquids. They should wear comfortable clothes such as shorts, a t-shirt and sneakers. Please no sandals!

Drop-off and pick-up have always been a difficult procedure before and after camp.

PLEASE FOLLOW THE DIRECTIONS FOR EACH LOCATION; it makes the process smoother, quicker and **SAFER** for your child.

Atkinson: Due to the overflow of traffic onto Mass. Ave, we will continue with the double line procedure.

Please enter Atkinson through the Mass. Ave entrance and continue slowly around the corner towards the baseball field. We will have staff in place to guide you up to the pick up point. If you arrive, and the first line is backed up to the entrance, our staff will guide you in making a second line adjacent to the first line. This line will not come all the way up to the pick-up point due to safety reasons, but will be a place to wait until the first line is finished picking up their children. Our first and foremost concern is the safety of the children, and we will do the best we can to make the process as quick as possible.

Drummond: Please enter Milk St. through the Chestnut St. entrance for both pick-up and drop-off! **DO NOT** enter from Johnson St. for pick up or drop off. You will be asked to drive around to the end of Milk St. and turn around if entering from Johnson St. Counselors will be at the top of the hill to escort your children out of the car and across the street.

*We ask that you make a large sign with the last name(s) of the child/children you are picking up in an effort to make the process as smooth as possible. *

The Town of North Andover offers children's shows weekly at the common. Each week Atkinson campers will be offered a chance to attend the shows if they please. If they choose not to attend, counselors will be staying at the camp and the day will continue as normal.

Children are allowed to walk and ride bikes to camp with permission from their parents. If your child is going to walk/ride to camp, **please fill out the attached permission slip.** If your child is going home with someone else, please write a note and give it to the coordinators in the morning. If your child is going to be dismissed early, **you must sign them out.** Please speak with a staff member and make sure to sign the early release form.

*If your child has medication that needs to be taken during camp hours, please bring the medication on the first day. Also, if your child has any allergy medication, please bring that as well. We ask that all medication be brought in a plastic bag along with a small picture of the child and a note card containing what the medication is and how it is to be administered. Also, any pertinent information regarding the allergy/medication **NEEDS** to be included on the card.
